POSITION DESCRIPTION

Position Summary

Responsible for assisting in the acquisition and daily care of a living collection of terrestrial and semi-aquatic organisms at KLCC Aquaria for use in displays and show presentations.

Essential Position Functions

- Ensures that the environmental, nutritional and psychological needs of terrestrial animals are maintained as per standard operating guidelines on a day to day basis.
- Communicates to Head Curator of any issues identified, and assist in developing a course of action to rectify the situation.
- Follow established written standards and protocols for all exhibits to ensure the highest standards for water quality, operational efficiency, cleanliness and animal health.
- Daily activities related to cleaning, maintenance, feeding and other husbandry activities of the terrestrial exhibits, back-of-house and food prep areas required on a day-to-day basis, including routine checking of all exhibits and LSS areas.
- Provide feedback to superiors on improvements to animal care, LSS, exhibits and activities/protocols.
- Report issues and assist in the development of actions to rectify any faulty equipment or problems, in particular identify animal health or water quality problems and report to supervisor, medical and water quality staff and assist to develop a plan of action to handle the care and treatment of affected animals.
- Maintain all curatorial areas so they are safe and clean.
- Assists relevant staff in maintaining an inventory of supplies, equipment and animal food items necessary for the daily care of the collection.

- Deliver extraordinary customer service to all aquarium guests and other customers
- Assisting to maintain documentation and databases for related to livestock (animal health and behavior, acquisitions, permits and mortalities), water quality, etc, where asked.
